Nestled into the pines of Flagstaff, Arizona, McKay Village has become the cornerstone for quality student housing at Northern Arizona University. Spanning 8.3 acres, the site plan sensitively positions three of the seven buildings on the sloping portion of the site in order to retain existing mature pine trees and views to the San Francisco Peaks. The remaining four buildings and a recreation building form the central open-space quadrangle for the project.
