construction project to ensure safety, quality, schedule and budgetary

goals are met.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Reviews construction plans with Landscape Supervisor or Superintendent before the project begins and throughout the project life to ensure completion according to contract.
- Performs human resource functions including training, evaluating, and disciplining of assigned personnel.
- Plans, organizes, and directs all tasks performed by crew leaders, operators, pipe fitters, laborers, suppliers, and subcontractors at the construction site.
- Trains and coaches assigned personnel to develop job related skills.
- Ensures quality workmanship and efficient production of the construction project.
- Manages worksite safety according to the company's Safety and Health Plan by monitoring the work performed by company and subcontractor personnel.
- Conducts "tailgate safety meetings" and oversees the safe operation of construction equipment.
- Conducts daily inspections of all construction equipment used at the jobsite and takes necessary corrective action to ensure safe operation.
- Verifies sufficient Blue Stake markings and protects utility lines and other trade's work from damage from our construction.
- Ensures that the quality and quantity of materials delivered to construction site are according to the purchase order.
- Attends and participates in weekly foreman meeting.
- Completes requires paperwork including Daily Timesheets, Weekly Project Reports, Safety Meeting Reports, Equipment Sheets, and Material Requests.
- Reviews and tracks Construction Schedules to manage material deliveries, ensure efficient equipment and manpower usage, and minimized demands on Purchasing Dept.
- Participate in In-House walkthrough with Superintendent and completes punchlist items.

- Prepares irrigation as-builds documenting changes and dimensions of primary equipment and mainlines.
- Assists the Superintendent with the completion and documentation of any work not covered in the contract.

Administration

- Prepares payroll information, employee documentation, and jobsite information in order to minimize extra demands on administration staff.
- Document project changes and extra work charges properly and promptly.
